

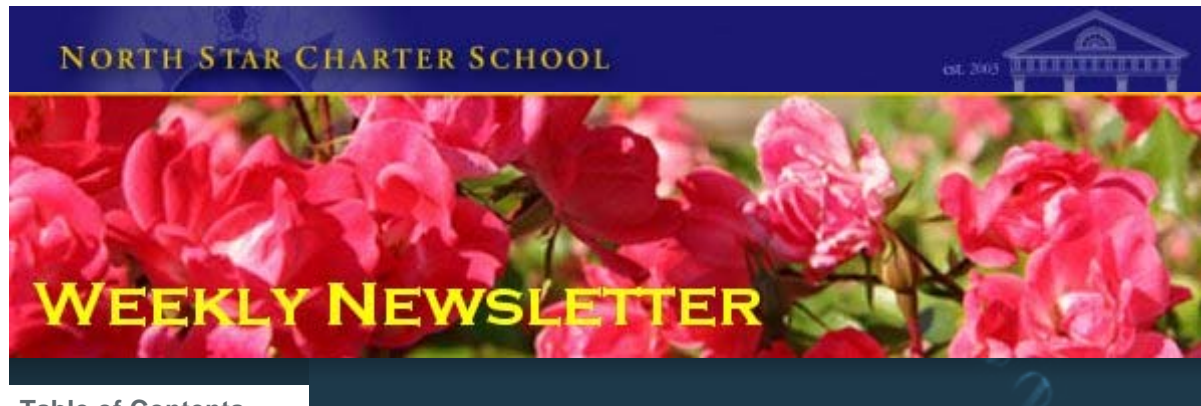

may be made of any type of clay - please wrap in bubble wrap when placed in box. (Not in bubble wrap).

All art work must be no larger than 11" by 14" including mat and/or frame. (Pre-cut mats stores or at Wal-Mart). Please mat your art work. Frames are optional. By matting or fra present your art in a more finished, professional manner.
