3 composition books (LA, Science, SS)

2 graph composition notebooks-1/4 inch, if possible. (math)

1 set of 24 colored pencils

1 hand-held pencil sharpener with shavings holder

300 sheets of college-ruled notebook paper (put some in binder and give homeroom teacher the rest so that as you run out, teacher can replenish for you)

1 ruler with inches and mm (keep at home; Mrs. Hawkins has one for you to use in class)

2 protractors (keep one at home for homework)

1 compass (keep in pencil pouch, as you will need it in math class and at home)

1 calculator (Dollar Store quality, or lack of, is fine[⊙])

10 regular sheet protectors-community supplies (give to Mrs. Hawkins)

3" heavy-duty binder, zipper with handle, such as a Trapper Keeper, (Optional if other organizational methods work for your son/daughter)

1 pencil pouch with 3 holes (to fit in binder)

5 dividers (label prior to class: science, math, SS, ELA, and elective class)

24 - #2 Ticonderoga pencils, sharpened (keep 12 in your pencil pouch and give the rest to your homeroom teacher so that as you run out, teacher can replenish for you)
