
North Star Families,

As teachers and administrators, our #1 goal is to keep your kids <u>safe</u> while they receive an excellent education on our North Star campus. Our state's Pupil Transportation Manual stresses the importance of ensuring safety at all pupil loading and unloading areas. In order to accommodate this, we need to ensure that our buses are able to maintain the one-way traffic that they're entitled to; "All school bus traffic should be considered as one-way traffic flow..."¹ "The Transportation Manual encourages administrators that, "Where necessary, traffic control devices should be provided to assist school traffic to enter regular flow". Therefore, cones and staff will be placed near the southern entrance to help direct our traffic flow (prevent use of the southern entrance/exit) as families adjust to these requests until permanent signage is obtained.

- Utilize the east parking lot area, to wait for your student after school
- Use the crosswalks, to keep our families safe
- Do not enter or exit via the southern entrance
- Do not park in the southern lot, for parent pick-up/drop-off
- Do not use your cell phone, while driving on North Star's campus
