2018-2019 STUDENT DRIVING AND PARKING AGREEMENT

Students and parents are required to thoroughly read and sign this document before returning.

Parking at school is a privilege that is earned by driving safely and abiding by the following expectations:

- Along with this signed form, students will be required to submit a copy of their driver's license, vehicle registration(s) and proof of insurance. This information will be kept in a secure location.
- Students who park on campus are required to park in the designated Student Parking Lot.
- Students will be required to display their parking placard at all times on the rearview mirror.
- Should a vehicle become disabled contact the SSO or the secondary office.
- Handicapped parking is state mandated only. Parking for students with temporary disabilities due to injuries may be obtained on an individual basis through the secondary office.
- All drivers must abide by the State of Idaho Motor Vehicle Statutes regarding motor vehicle operation and seatbelt usage when driving on school grounds. Students will be required to wear their seatbelts at all times when driving in the parking lot. **Parking lot speed is 10 mph.**
- Use of cell phones or any other electronic device while operating a motor vehicle is strictly prohibited.
- Any vehicle that is deemed unsafe to drive will not be permitted on school grounds.
- Supervision is provided for the parking lot; however, the NSCS is not responsible for damages to or thefts from vehicles. Students are cautioned not to leave valuables in their vehicles. Parked vehicles should be locked at all times.
- Vehicles are subject to search and seizure if there is a reasonable suspicion that drugs, alcohol, weapons, stolen property or other contraband are believed to be present.
- Students are required to notify the Safe School Officer or secondary office should their vehicle become disabled on school grounds. Disabled vehicles must be towed within 48 hours.
- **Students who operate a motor vehicle on campus should understand their duties, responsibilities and the parking lot rules and regulations as listed above. Students who violate parking lot regulations are subject to revocation of parking privileges and or disciplinary action.**
