Program Details:

Who: Qualified Juniors and Seniors

Internship Dates: September 2018 – May 2019 (2 semesters)

Hours Available: 2 days for 8-10 hours per week

Students

- Apply for and secure internship
- Attend internship required workdays for 2 semesters
- Attend assigned internship class days at NS to reflect on internship and continue learning workplace preparation skills
- Complete quarterly evaluations with internship teacher and supervisor
- Present final internship project during the last two weeks of the semester

North Star

- Help secure internship opportunities when needed
- Prepare students for the workplace during internship instructional class time, ie. Resume writing, Dress for Success, etc.
- Internship teacher will provide two evaluations during each semester and will check in with supervisors to provide support when needed.

Employer

- Identify an internship opportunity for 8-10 hours, 2 days a week
- Identify a supervisor to oversee and evaluate intern together with internship teacher
- Assist intern in identifying their final project subject by giving them a real business problem to solve or mastery of a specific area of knowledge
- Educate intern on future career opportunities within your industry
