**Science/Social Studies**

- 1 two pocket folder
- 1 set of 12 colored pencils
- 1 8.5"x7" sewn-binding composition notebook--NOT spiral, perforated, or tape-bound (label with your name and Science/Social Studies)
- 1 small bottle of liquid glue
- 3 glue sticks (Give to Miss Speicher)
- 1 pack of at least 15 durable page tabs (Give to Miss Speicher)

**Language Arts**

- 1 8.5"x7" sewn-binding composition notebook--NOT spiral, perforated, or tape-bound (Label with your name and "ELA")
- 1 package of college-ruled lined paper (give to Mr. Whitt)
- 3-4 erasable blue/black pens
- 3 different-colored highlighters
- 1 packet of notecards

**Math**

- 2 **graph** composition notebooks- $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, if possible. (Label with your name and "Math"; 2nd is back-up and can stay in locker)
- 4 glue sticks (give to Mrs. Hawkins)
- 8 red pens (keep 4 in pouch; give others to Mrs. Hawkins)
- 2 rulers with inches and mm (keep one at home and one in pencil pouch)
- 2 protractors (keep one at home and one in pouch)
- 1 compass (keep in pencil pouch)
- 1 calculator (Dollar Store quality is fine)
- 1 box of either quart or gallon sized bags

**General Recommendations:**

- 1 pencil pouch
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pencil eraser
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener with shavings holder
- 2 black permanent markers
- 5 dividers or 5 pocket folders that fit in binder labeled with class names
- 1 dry erase marker eraser (such as an old sock)
- 12 dry erase markers (4 in pencil pouch; others to homeroom teacher)
- 48 #2 pencils, sharpened (keep 12 in pencil pouch; others to homeroom teacher)
- 3" heavy-duty binder such as a Trapper Keeper (Optional if other organizational methods work for your child)

**Give to Homeroom Teacher-**2 large boxes of Kleenex and 2 containers of disinfectant wipes
