

Job Posting: Special Education Behavioral Interventionist

Skilled CBRS worker (Community based rehabilitative services worker, previously PSR) or Behavior Interventionist to support new skills generalization in the general education classroom for students with developmental disabilities and challenging behaviors. Behavior Interventionists, Therapists and CBRS workers teach strategies to students with academic, social and emotional struggles who have a variety of challenges throughout their day. Staff will also support the use of accommodations to encourage assignment completion, student engagement, reward appropriate behavior and redirect behaviors to encourage appropriate learning behaviors and social interactions with peers and teachers. This position utilizes a variety of approaches and interventions that promote recovery and successful school integration for children with health, emotional, behavioral and psychological disorders.
